READING WATER SYSTEM MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

The Reading Area Water Authority is requesting mandatory water restrictions for the READING WATER SYSTEM.

Due to a lack of recent rainfall, the System's source water levels are very low.

We are requiring that consumers reduce usage by 10-15% until this notice is lifted.

The following water uses are considered nonessential and should be curtailed during this notice.

Restricted Water Uses

- Watering lawns, gardens, landscaped areas, trees shrubs and outdoor plants.
- · Watering golf courses.
- Washing paved surfaces, such as streets, sidewalks, driveways, garages, parking areas, tennis courts and patios.
- Operating water fountains, artificial waterfalls and reflecting pools.
- Washing vehicles.
- Serving water in eating places unless specifically requested by the individual.
- Filling and topping off swimming pools.

We will inform you when the requested water use restrictions are lifted.

Clarification on water use during this Notice:

- Fresh water may be used to water outdoor gardens if the garden is used to produce food.
- Other gardens may be watered by means of a bucket, can or handheld hose equipped with an automatic shutoff nozzle.
- Personally owned vehicles should be washed using buckets or a hand-held hose equipped with an automatic shutoff nozzle used for pre-rinsing and rinsing not to exceed two minutes total spray time.
- Swimming pools should be covered when not in use, and only topped off if necessary.
